Steps to Apply for a PGWP

- 1) Log into your <u>IRCC account</u> and answer eligibility questions.
 - a. Once you sign in to your account, you need to go to the **Start your application** section on the account welcome page and click **Apply to come to Canada.** On the next page, scroll down to the **I do not have a personal reference code** section and select the **Visitor visa, study and/or work permit** button. Then you will be prompted to answer the eligibility questions.
